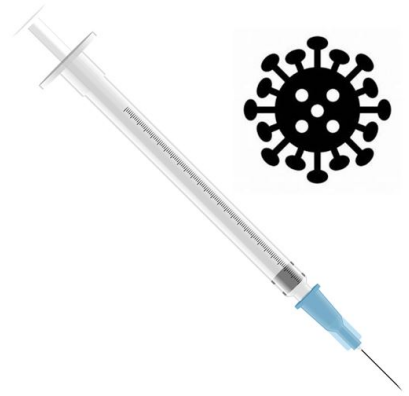

Veterans:

1. Who is currently eligible to receive a COVID-19 vaccine through the VA?

- Veterans who are enrolled in VA health care.
- Veterans who are 65 years of age and older
- Veterans with certain high-risk conditions. Please speak with your provider if you think you may be high risk.

You must have an appointment to receive a vaccine.

2. How can I make an appointment?

The best way to contact us is to send an email to STLCOVIDVetVaccine@va.gov

In the email you must include:

- Your full name
- A good contact phone number
- Please tell us if you are already enrolled in VA Health Care
- Do not include your social security number
- Send a Secure Message to your Primary Care Provider's Triage Group on your Premium My HealthVet account
