Brief Job Description

Required Qualifications

Licensed Practical Nurse

- Assists the Physician and/or Nurse Practitioner with patient exams.
- Gathers patient history/Responsible for documentation
- Sets up and draws any necessary labs and performs any special procedures as requested.
- Provides patient education and counseling.
- Responsible for providing professional nursing care to clinic patients under the supervision of physicians/nurse practitioner or the Clinic Manager.

- Graduate of an accredited school of nursing for Licensed Practical Nurses.
- Licensed as an LPN by the Missouri State Board of Nursing.
- BCLS certification required, ACLS certification preferred.
- Current licensure by the Missouri State Board of Nursing.
- One year of experience as an LPN in physician office setting highly desired.

Medic I & Medic II

- Ensure that all program expectations and rules are adhered to, and report behaviors to supervisor
- Document and/or report at shift change and/or in client/patient record any exceptional behavior and/or areas of concerns related to client's behaviors.
- Assist in admission/orientation process including obtaining vital signs if applicable.
- Coordinate incoming calls and respond to crisis calls as necessary. Assign bed/recliner for consumer
- Assist in orientation of client/patient; screen & monitor clients medical needs

Medic I

- High School education; OR equivalent and (2) years responsible employment history
- Certified EMT with current license

Medic II

- High school diploma, or equivalent;
- Licensed as a Paramedic in Missouri;
- One (1) year experience in paramedic position.

Required Qualifications

Behavioral Health Technician

- Participate as an active member of the treatment team by helping to identify client's strengths, needs, abilities and preferences.
- Ensure that all program expectations and rules are adhered to.
- Adhere to all medication policies and work with trained nursing staff to ensure all medication policies are followed .
- Assist in admission/orientation process including obtaining vital signs if applicable.
- Provide client/patient transportation as needed.

- High School education or equivalent and two (2) years responsible employment history
- Exceptions to the qualifications listed may be made by the appropriate Executive Team member.
- Bachelor's Degree OR
- MAADC I or II

Peer Support Specialist *

*Positions available for the Sobering Center and EPICC

- Assist participants in developing treatment plans.
- Complete regular communication with referral sources/guardians regarding progress, transition planning, and pertinent clinical issues and documentation.
- Participate in staffing to assure continuity of care.
- Make or assist in outside referral of issues not able to be addressed within the treatment milieu.
- Assist in scheduling of treatment and arranging transportation.

- Self identify as a present or former client of mental health or substance use services OR in recovery from mental health or substance use disorder.
- Be at least 21 years of age
- Have a high school diploma or equivalent
- Pass background check or request an exception to the findings if/when applicable.
- Complete a state approved training program and if required, pass a standardized examination

Community Behavioral Health Liaison

- Coordinate services and develop local systems of care for individuals with behavioral health needs
- Participate on local law enforcement Crisis Intervention Teams (CIT) or other initiatives that assist law enforcement.
- Collaborate with local partners in treatment or diversion courts assisting individuals with behavioral health needs
- Provide or coordinate training and consultation on behavioral health issues .

Level 2 CBHL
Master's degree or higher in psychology, social work, counseling, or related behavioral health field and be an experienced, qualified mental health professional (QMHP), or qualified addiction professional (QAP)

Level 1 CBHL
Bachelor's degree in psychology, social work, counseling, or related behavioral health field, with one year of experience

Security Officer

- Assist in admission/orientation process of safety search of client/patient and belongings
- Inventory and lock up / return client belongings as per policy.
- Monitor client activities occurring on shifts.
- Monitor camera's as necessary/needed.
- Role models verbal and nonverbal interventions and techniques related to behavior management.
- Ensure all clients/patients are accounted for.
- Ensure precaution protocols are adhered to.

- Have a high school diploma or equivalent;
- At least one (1) year experience in a similar role.

Community Support Specialist

- Provide a holistic, person-centered care with emphasis on personal strengths, skill acquisition, harm reduction.
- Use interventions, based on individual strengths and needs, to develop interpersonal/social, family, community and independent living functional skills.
- Facilitate and support recovery/resiliency through activities including: defining recovery/resiliency concepts.
- Provide information and education in order to learn about and manage mental illness/serious emotional disturbance and/or substance use disorders

- A mental health professional as defined in 9 CSR 10 - 7.140 (2) (QQ) (Missouri);
- An individual with a bachelor's degree in a human services field.
- An individual with any four year degree and two years of qualifying experience (see full job description)
- Any four year combination of higher education and qualifying experience, or
- An individual with four years of qualifying experience.
